Minimum Qualifications: Candidates must have a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Spanish language, literature, or an equivalent, proven written and verbal proficiency in Spanish and a PA certification in Spanish K-12. Candidates must demonstrate expertise in various levels of Spanish ranging from level I to level III. Skills must include, but are not limited to, experience with both synchronous and asynchronous teaching, familiarity with integrating technology in planning, proficient written and verbal communication, current clearances to work within a Catholic school in the Diocese of Pittsburgh, a commitment to Catholic education and a clear understanding of the expectations of all constituents in a college-preparatory high school setting such as Oakland Catholic High School. Ideally, the candidate will demonstrate a genuine willingness to grow within the role and actively pursue professional growth opportunities and ways to enhance the World Language Department.

Responsibilities/Requirements:

- Create dynamic lesson plans, activities and content to help students achieve oral and written proficiency.
- Assigning valuable coursework and grading assignments in a timely manner
- Preparing students for both oral and written assessments.
- Teaching Spanish culture
- Collaborating with the Department Chair and other colleagues to create a comprehensive curriculum that prepares students to take higher level Spanish courses.

Working Conditions
